Patient Instructions for Nuclear Medicine Scans

Note: Scans followed by an asterisk require no special preparation.

1. Bone Scan - After receiving an injection you will be required to drink one quart of fluid during a 2 to 4 hour period. You will then return for the camera images at a time that will be given to you when you receive the injection.

2. Cardiac Stress Tests - Nothing by mouth for 4 hours prior to study. Wear comfortable exercise clothing and footwear. You will exercise on a treadmill for the first part of the study, and images will be obtained immediately after the exercise. You will then return for more images (no exercise) 3 to 4 hours later. It is very important that no caffeine be consumed 24 hours prior to the test, including certain medications, chocolate, soda, tea, and even decaffeinated tea and coffee. Check with your cardiologist to see if your usual medications are to be taken the morning of the test.
